Summary: Home schooling requirements

A BILL TO AMEND CHAPTER 56 OF TITLE 59 OF THE 1976 CODE, RELATING TO THE ATTENDANCE OF PUPILS, BY ADDING SECTION 59-65-35, TO PROVIDE THE LOCATIONS WHERE A PARENT MAY PROVIDE FOR THE ACADEMIC INSTRUCTION OF THEIR CHILDREN IN A HOME SCHOOLING PROGRAM; TO AMEND SECTIONS 59-65-40, 59-65-45, AND 59-65-47, RELATING TO HOME SCHOOLING REQUIREMENTS, TO PROVIDE THAT THE PARENTS OF HOME SCHOOLED CHILDREN ARE NOT REQUIRED TO BE THE EXCLUSIVE EDUCATORS OF THEIR CHILDREN; AND TO AMEND SECTION 59-65-46, RELATING TO THE HOME SCHOOLING OF A FOSTER CHILD, TO PROVIDE THAT FOSTER PARENTS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO BE THE EXCLUSIVE EDUCATORS OF THEIR FOSTER CHILDREN THAT ARE HOME SCHOOLED.
