Summary: Eavesdropping or Peeping Tom, unlawful on public property; Crimes and Offenses, Property

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 16-17-470, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE OFFENSES OF EAVESDROPPING AND BEING A PEEPING TOM, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT IT IS UNLAWFUL TO BE AN EAVESDROPPER OR A PEEPING TOM ON PUBLIC PROPERTY, AND TO DEVISE THE DEFINITION OF THE TERM "PEEPING TOM" TO INCLUDE PUBLIC PROPERTY.
