AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 50-11-65, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE TRAINING OF BIRD DOGS, SO AS TO DEFINE "TRAINING BIRDS", TO PROVIDE FOR THE USE OF TRAINING BIRDS DURING THE CLOSED SEASON, AND TO PROVIDE THAT TRAINING MUST HAVE MINIMAL DISTURBANCE ON WILD BIRDS. - ratified title
