Summary: School districts

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 59-63-20, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO QUALIFICATIONS FOR ATTENDANCE AT THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE PARENTS OR LEGAL GUARDIANS OF A CHILD ENROLLED IN A PUBLIC SCHOOL OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT COMPOSED OF AN AREA WHICH IS LESS THAN AN ENTIRE COUNTY MUST HAVE REGISTERED AT LEAST ONE MOTOR VEHICLE IN THEIR NAME IN THE COUNTY WHERE THE SCHOOL IS LOCATED WITH AN ADDRESS ON THE REGISTRATION CARD WHICH IS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THAT SCHOOL DISTRICT.
