S 1010 General Bill, By Ford

Summary: Heritage Representation, Flags, Confederate, Black Liberation; Buildings, State House, Native American History Monument

A BILL TO ENACT THE SOUTH CAROLINA HERITAGE REPRESENTATION ACT SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR CREATION OF A NATIVE AMERICAN HISTORY MONUMENT ON THE STATE HOUSE GROUNDS; TO CREATE A COMMISSION TO SELECT THE DESIGN AND LOCATION OF THE MONUMENT AND PERFORM CERTAIN OTHER FUNCTIONS; TO DEVELOP A FLAG DISPLAYING AN INSIGNIA OF SIGNIFICANCE TO THE NATIVE AMERICAN PEOPLE TO BE APPROVED BY THE NATIVE AMERICAN COUNCIL TO THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA; TO PROVIDE FOR REMOVAL OF THE CONFEDERATE FLAG FROM ATOP THE STATE HOUSE, AND FROM THE CHAMBERS OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES; AND TO PROVIDE FOR PLACEMENT OF THE CONFEDERATE FLAG AT THE ROBERT E. LEE MEMORIAL AND THE BLACK LIBERATION FLAG AT THE AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY MONUMENT.
