S 1047 General Bill, By Sheheen and Elliott

Summary: Unlawful to drive a motor vehicle through a school zone while using a cell phone

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 56-1-55 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR A PERSON TO DRIVE A MOTOR VEHICLE THROUGH A SCHOOL ZONE WHILE USING A CELLULAR TELEPHONE OR TEXT MESSAGING DEVICE WHEN THE SCHOOL ZONE'S WARNING LIGHTS HAVE BEEN ACTIVATED, AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION.
