S 1073 General Bill, By Ryberg, Giese, Leventis, Martin, Wilson and Setzler

Summary: Public Safety Department, Motor vehicles registration, Insurance; to verify liability coverage; reinstatement provisions

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 56-10-553, RELATING TO THE COLLECTION OF DATA BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY REGARDING MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION AND INSURANCE, SO AS TO INCREASE THE TIME PERIOD WITHIN WHICH RANDOM INSURANCE SURVEY FORMS MUST BE RETURNED FROM FIFTEEN DAYS AFTER RECEIPT TO THIRTY DAYS AFTER RECEIPT; AND TO PROVIDE THAT IF A PERSON PROVIDES PROOF OF INSURANCE WITHIN SEVEN DAYS OF THE SUSPENSION OF VEHICLE REGISTRATION FOR FAILURE TO RETURN THE FORM, THE FEE FOR REINSTATING THE REGISTRATION SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED.
