S 1089 General Bill, By Glover

Summary: Marion County, consolidation of school districts; provisions for millage, transfer of assets, liabilities, and general obligation bonds

A BILL TO PROVIDE THAT MARION COUNTY ON JULY 1, 2002, SHALL CONSIST OF ONE CONSOLIDATED SCHOOL DISTRICT TO BE COMPOSED OF THE THREE PRESENT SCHOOL DISTRICTS OF THE COUNTY WITH THESE THREE PRESENT SCHOOL DISTRICTS OF THE COUNTY BEING ABOLISHED ON JULY 1, 2002; TO PROVIDE THAT THE CONSOLIDATED SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL BE GOVERNED BY THE MARION COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION; TO PROVIDE FOR THE MANNER IN WHICH A SCHOOL BUDGET FOR THE CONSOLIDATED DISTRICT MUST BE PREPARED AND SCHOOL TAX MILLAGE DETERMINED AND LEVIED; TO PROVIDE FOR THE TRANSFER OF THE ASSETS AND LIABILITIES OF THE THREE PRESENT SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO THE CONSOLIDATED DISTRICT OF WHICH THEY ARE A PART; AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE MANNER IN WHICH THE CONSTITUTIONAL DEBT LIMITATION OF THE CONSOLIDATED SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS SHALL BE DETERMINED.
