Summary: Driver training schools

A BILL TO AMEND SECTIONS 56-23-10, 56-23-40, 56-23-60, 56-23-70, 56-23-80, AND 56-23-85, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE LICENSING OF DRIVER TRAINING SCHOOLS, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A LICENSEE MUST HAVE A PERMANENT LOCATION IN THIS STATE, TO INCREASE THE LICENSE FEE, TO REQUIRE A DRIVING TRAINING SCHOOL TO OBTAIN A SURETY BOND, TO REQUIRE A DRIVER TRAINING SCHOOL'S RECORDS TO BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES FOR REVIEW, TO REQUIRE DRIVER INSTRUCTOR QUALIFYING COURSES TO BE OFFERED AT LEAST ONCE INSTEAD OF TWICE A YEAR, TO INCREASE THE FEE FOR A TEMPORARY INSTRUCTOR PERMIT AND REQUIRE THE FEE TO BE PLACED IN THE STATE GENERAL FUND, TO SUBJECT A TEMPORARY DRIVER INSTRUCTOR'S ACTIVITIES AND INSTRUCTION TO AN AUDIT OF DRIVING SKILLS AND CLASSROOM TEACHING BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES, TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON ENGAGED IN CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION OR BEHIND THE WHEEL INSTRUCTION MUST HOLD AN INSTRUCTION PERMIT OR TEMPORARY DRIVER INSTRUCTOR PERMIT, TO PROVIDE THAT A PRIVATE HIGH SCHOOL INSTRUCTOR IS NOT REQUIRED TO PAY A FEE FOR A PERMIT, AND TO PROVIDE THE FEES FROM THE SALE OF INSTRUCTOR PERMITS MUST BE DEPOSITED IN THE STATE GENERAL FUND.
