Summary: School districts, teachers; teaching certificate, award of conditional when teaching critical needs area

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 59-26-35 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON NOT CERTIFIED TO TEACH IN THIS STATE WHO POSSESSES PARTICULAR EXPERTISE IN A SUBJECT AREA OF CRITICAL NEED OR IN OTHER SUBJECT AREAS AS DETERMINED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION MAY BE AWARDED A CONDITIONAL TEACHING CERTIFICATE FOR UP TO THREE YEARS UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS, AND TO PROVIDE THAT THESE TEACHERS SHALL BE KNOWN AND CLASSIFIED AS "EXECUTIVE TEACHERS".
