A Bill to amend Section 50-15-60, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to costs of nongame and endangered species' conservation programs, so as to provide for permits for the sale of alligator products and that the proceeds from permit sales and portions of the proceeds from the sale of alligator products may be used to pay the costs of the Alligator Control Management Program and placed in the Game Protection Fund and administered according to the provisions of Section 50-1-150.-amended title
