A BILL TO AMEND CHAPTER 11, TITLE 1, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTIONS 1-11-490 AND 1-11-500, SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR PERMANENT PLACEMENT OF THE UNITED STATES FLAG, THE SOUTH CAROLINA STATE FLAG AND THE SOUTH CAROLINA INFANTRY BATTLE FLAG OF THE CONFEDERATE STATES OF AMERICA AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROTECTION OF MEMORIALS, MONUMENTS, STREETS, PARKS AND OTHER PUBLIC AREAS, TO ADD A NEW ARTICLE TO CHAPTER 11 OF TITLE 1, RELATING TO LEGAL HOLIDAYS FOR PERMANENT STATE EMPLOYEES, TO AMEND SECTION 10-1-160, RELATING TO DISPLAY OF CERTAIN FLAGS, TO ESTABLISH SPECIFIC VOTE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE AMENDMENT OR REPEAL OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS, AND TO DESIGNATE THIS ACT AS THE SOUTH CAROLINA HISTORICAL MONUMENTS AND MEMORIALS PROTECTION ACT.
