Summary: Equine professionals and equine activity sponsors

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 47-9-710, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO DEFINITIONS FOR PURPOSES OF EQUINE LIABILITY IMMUNITY, SO AS TO INCLUDE TRAIL RIDING IN THE DEFINITION OF "EQUINE ACTIVITY" AND TO EXPAND THE DEFINITION OF "EQUINE ACTIVITY SPONSOR" TO INCLUDE A LANDOWNER WHO HAS GIVEN PERMISSION FOR THE USE OF HIS LAND FOR AN EQUINE ACTIVITY; AND TO AMEND SECTION 47-9-730, RELATING TO WARNING SIGNS REQUIRED TO BE POSTED BY EQUINE PROFESSIONALS AND EQUINE ACTIVITY SPONSORS, SO AS TO INCLUDE A REQUIREMENT THAT WARNING SIGNS ARE TO BE POSTED AT THE ENTRANCE TO RIDING TRAILS.
