S 1300 General Bill, By Leventis

Summary: Person may not have more than one valid identification

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 56-1-20 OF THE 1976 CODE, RELATING TO THE REQUIREMENT TO BE ISSUED A DRIVER'S LICENSE TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE IN THIS STATE, TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON MAY NOT HAVE MORE THAN ONE VALID IDENTIFICATION, DRIVER'S LICENSE, OR SPECIAL IDENTIFICATION CARD; TO AMEND SECTION 56-1-3350, RELATING TO SPECIAL IDENTIFICATION CARDS, TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON MAY NOT HAVE MORE THAN ONE VALID IDENTIFICATION, DRIVER'S LICENSE, OR SPECIAL IDENTIFICATION CARD; AND TO AMEND SECTION 56-1-50, RELATING TO THE ALLOCATION OF FEES TO THE STATE NON-FEDERAL AID HIGHWAY FUND, TO PROVIDE THAT ALL FEES DERIVED FROM ISSUING BEGINNER'S PERMITS ARE CREDITED TO THE FUND.
