Summary: Building Code modifications do not require readoption by the Building Codes Council

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 6-9-40 OF THE 1976 CODE, RELATING TO THE ADOPTION AND PROMULGATION OF CERTAIN BUILDING CODES, STANDARDS, AND PROCEDURES, TO PROVIDE THAT MODIFICATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE SOUTH CAROLINA BUILDING CODES COUNCIL DO NOT REQUIRE READOPTION OF SUBSEQUENT EDITIONS OF THE BUILDING CODES AND A PROCEDURE FOR RECONSIDERATION OF THOSE MODIFICATIONS.
