A Bill to amend Section 57-7-20, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to depositing foreign substances on highways, so as to provide for additional penalties when any person knowingly, with malicious intent, violates the provisions of this Section or when personal injury or death results from a violation.-amended title
