S 1423 Joint Resolution, By Ford

Summary: Motor fuels user fee

A JOINT RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE THAT THE IMPOSITION OF THE MOTOR FUELS USER FEE PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 28, TITLE 12 OF THE 1976 CODE IS SUSPENDED EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2006, THROUGH THE EARLIER OF SEPTEMBER 30, 2006, OR THE DATE ESTIMATED BY THE BOARD OF ECONOMIC ADVISORS THAT UNOBLIGATED REVENUES FROM INCREASED ENFORCEMENT COLLECTIONS OFFSET THE REVENUES NOT COLLECTED BECAUSE OF THE SUSPENSION, TO PROVIDE THAT THE OFFSET AMOUNT OF UNOBLIGATED ENFORCED COLLECTIONS REVENUE MUST BE CREDITED TO THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND, AND TO PROVIDE THAT MOTOR FUEL WHOLESALERS MUST PASS ON THE SAVINGS REALIZED BY THIS SUSPENSION OF THE MOTOR FUELS USER FEE TO MOTOR FUEL RETAILERS WHEN INVOICING THEM FOR THE COST OF MOTOR FUEL DURING THE SUSPENSION PERIOD.
