### **H\*2252 (Rat #0429, Act #0352 of 1982) General Bill, By D.M. Beasley and J.I. Rogers**

A Bill to amend Section 56-1-210, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the expiration and renewal of drivers' licenses, so as to provide that visual examination shall be required of persons who have no more than five points instead of four points for moving traffic violations in two years instead of three years prior to application for renewal.-at
