Summary: Psychotropic medication

A BILL TO AMEND ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 63, TITLE 59 OF THE 1976 CODE, BY ADDING SECTION 59-63-95, TO PROVIDE THAT A SCHOOL MAY NOT DENY A STUDENT ACCESS TO PROGRAMS OR SERVICES BECAUSE THE STUDENT'S PARENT HAS REFUSED TO PLACE THE STUDENT ON PSYCHOTROPIC MEDICATION, TO PROHIBIT A TEACHER OR SCHOOL PERSONNEL FROM REQUIRING A STUDENT TAKE MEDICATION, AND TO PROVIDE THAT A PARENT MAY REFUSE A PSYCHOLOGICAL SCREENING OF THE STUDENT.
