### H 2514 General Bill, By J.W. Tucker and M.J. Cooper

A Bill to provide that no water or sewage system owned or operated by a county, municipality, special purpose district, or political subdivision of this State may be extended, leased, or operated in the unincorporated area of any county other than the county or counties where it is already owned or operated except under a certain condition.
