S*0252 (Rat #0233, Act #0165 of 1987) General Bill, By Leatherman

A Bill to amend the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Section 43-21-150 so as to require the Commission on Aging, with the cooperation of the Long Term Care Council and the Department of Insurance, to develop and implement a program to educate citizens concerning the availability of long term care services, the lifetime risk of spending time in a nursing home, and the coverage available for long term care services through Medicare, Medicaid, and private insurance policies, and the limitations of this coverage, and the availability of home equity conversion alternatives; to require the Commission on Aging to study the costs and benefits of establishing a statewide computer-based volunteer services credit program, and to make a report to the General Assembly regarding this study by July 1, 1987; and to require the Commission on Consumer Affairs, with the cooperation of the Department of Insurance, to study the development of life care communities in this State and report its findings to the General Assembly by January 1, 1988.-amended title
