**H 3155 General Bill, By J.L. Harris, P.B. Harris, R.L. Helmly, Sharpe and R.R. Woods**

***Similar (S 0752)***

A Bill to amend Section 44-51-50, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to involuntary admission of an alcoholic or drug addict to treatment facility for nonemergency hospitalization, so as to reduce from two to one the number of physicians required to certify that the person to be admitted has been examined and is an alcoholic or drug addict.
