Summary: Campaign reports, contribution of one hundred dollars or more to be filed along with contributors; Elections, Ethics

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 8-13-1308, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE FILING OF CERTIFIED CAMPAIGN REPORTS BY CANDIDATES AND COMMITTEES, SO AS TO DELETE THE EXCEPTION OF SHOWING CONTRIBUTIONS OF ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS OR MORE IN A CERTIFIED CAMPAIGN REPORT FILED FIFTEEN DAYS BEFORE AN ELECTION AND DELETE THE EXCEPTION IN ALL CERTIFIED CAMPAIGN REPORTS REQUIRING THE NAMES AND ADDRESSES OF EACH PERSON MAKING A CONTRIBUTION OF MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS.
