A Bill to amend the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Section 23-31-185 so as to prohibit the manufacture, possession, sale, or transfer in this State of certain hollow-point bullets made of metal-encased plastic containing lead pellets which fragment on contact and which can penetrate body armor or other types of bullet-proof vests, to provide exceptions, and to provide penalties for violation.
