**H\*3253 (Rat #0624, Act #0494 of 1992) General Bill, By I.K. Rudnick, J.L.M. Cromer, K.G. Kempe, J.R. Klapman, R. Smith, C.Y. Waites and J.B. Wilder**

A Bill to amend Section 7-7-990, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to barrier-free polling places for physically handicapped electors, so as to provide that an elector who is permanently handicapped is not required to reregister in order to vote at the barrier-free polling place.
