**H\*3287 (Rat #0486, Act #0439 of 1986) General Bill, By P. Evatt, D.M. Beasley and Wilkins**

***Similar (S 0838)***

A Bill to amend Section 19-11-30, Code of Laws of South Carolina, relating to the competency of a husband or wife of a party to a legal proceeding to testify or give evidence, so as to require a husband or wife to disclose information given to them by the other during their marriage where the proceeding concerns or is based on criminal sexual conduct involving a minor or attempting to commit a lewd act upon a minor.
