### **H\*3292 (Rat #0611, Act #0489 of 1992) General Bill, By J.J. Bailey, Haskins and J.B. Wilder**

A Bill to amend Sections 7-15-320 and 7-15-340, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the persons qualified to vote by absentee ballot, so as to add persons seventy-two years of age or older; and to amend Section 7-11-20, relating to a political party holding a Presidential primary election, so as to provide for absentee ballots therefor under certain conditions if the Presidential primary is held on a Saturday.-amended title
