A Bill to amend Chapter 7 of Title 20, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the Childrens Code, by adding Article 21 so as to establish the State Council on Maternal, Infant, and Child Health; to provide for the purposes of the Article and the Council; to provide for Council membership, the Chairman, terms, vacancies, and compensation; to provide for the functions of the Council; and to provide for housing, funding, and staffing of the Council.
