Summary: Gaming Tourism Fund Act, Gambling, Watercraft, Casino boats, Taxation, Admissions tax

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 12-21-2425 ENACTING THE "GAMING TOURISM FUND ACT" BY IMPOSING A SIX DOLLAR LICENSE TAX ON EACH PAID ADMISSION TO A CASINO BOAT, TO PROVIDE THAT THIS TAX IS IN ADDITION TO THE ADMISSIONS TAX AND ALL OTHER TAXES AND FOR THE METHOD OF ITS PAYMENT, REPORTING, AND COLLECTION, TO DEFINE "CASINO BOAT," AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE REVENUE TO BE CREDITED TO A SEPARATE GAMING TOURISM FUND USED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION AND TOURISM FOR ITS OPERATIONS AND FOR COMMUNITY FESTIVALS.
