A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 59-63-550 SO AS TO PROHIBIT A STUDENT ADJUDICATED DELINQUENT OR CONVICTED OF CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT OR ASSAULT AND BATTERY OF A HIGH AND AGGRAVATED NATURE FROM ENROLLING IN OR ATTENDING A SCHOOL IN WHICH A VICTIM OF THE OFFENSE IS ENROLLED.
