A Bill to amend Sections 46-3-110, 47-13-400 and 47-13-420, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to monies derived from sale of inoculating materials and expenses involving appraisers of animals to be killed, so as to delete the requirement that sums derived from sale of inoculating materials shall be deposited daily in a bank and transmitted monthly to the State Treasurer and to provide that appraisers' expenses shall be paid by Clemson University instead of the Comptroller General.
