A Bill to reauthorize the existence of the South Carolina State Board of Psychology for six years and to amend Section 40-55-60, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the Code of Ethics for Psychologists, so as to authorize the adoption of the Code of Ethics for Psychologists and delete the specific reference to the Code published by the American Psychological Association and an unnecessary date and to require consultation and collaboration with physicians in extended psychotherapy cases, except where the client is seeing the psychologist for psychological evaluation or marital counseling.-amended title
