H 3607 General Bill, By Taylor

Summary: Healthcare decision for a child

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 20-7-652, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE WITHHOLDING OF HEALTH CARE FROM A CHILD FOR RELIGIOUS OR OTHER REASONS, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A HEALTH CARE DECISION MADE FOR A CHILD BY THE CHILD'S PARENT OR GUARDIAN DOES NOT CONSTITUTE ABUSE OR NEGLECT UNLESS THE DEPARTMENT PROVES BY A PREPONDERANCE OF THE EVIDENCE THAT THE TREATMENT PURSUED BY THE GUARDIAN OR PARENT IS AN UNREASONABLE OR IMPRUDENT TREATMENT FOR THE CHILD'S HEALTH CONDITION; TO PROVIDE THAT A PARENT OR GUARDIAN MAY OBTAIN A SECOND MEDICAL OPINION CONCERNING WHETHER A HEALTH CARE DECISION THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN MAKES FOR A CHILD IS REASONABLE AND PRUDENT; AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING CHANGES THROUGHOUT.
