H 3660 General Bill, By White, Haskins, Rice, Rivers, Stuart, Taylor, Trotter and Wilder

Summary: Motor vehicle drivers' license, alcohol-restricted, special restricted; fee increase; Transportation, Traffic violations

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 56-5-2951, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE SUSPENSION OF A PERSON'S DRIVER'S LICENSE, PERMIT, OR NONRESIDENT OPERATING PRIVILEGE, OR THE DENIAL OF THE ISSUANCE OF A LICENSE OR PERMIT TO A PERSON WHO DRIVES A MOTOR VEHICLE AND REFUSES TO SUBMIT TO A TEST TO DETERMINE HIS ALCOHOL CONCENTRATION, OR WHO HAS A CERTAIN ALCOHOL CONCENTRATION, SO AS TO INCREASE THE FEE FOR A TEMPORARY ALCOHOL RESTRICTED LICENSE, TO DELETE THE PROVISION THAT REQUIRES THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO USE THE FEE FOR ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE ISSUANCE OF TEMPORARY ALCOHOL DRIVER'S LICENSES, TO INCREASE THE FEE FOR A SPECIAL RESTRICTED DRIVER'S LICENSE, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE FEE COLLECTED FOR A SPECIAL RESTRICTED DRIVER'S LICENSE.
