Summary: Bill of Rights Day

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 53-3-166 SO AS TO DECLARE DECEMBER FIFTEENTH OF EACH YEAR AS BILL OF RIGHTS DAY IN SOUTH CAROLINA, AND TO ENCOURAGE ALL GOVERNMENTAL BODIES TO OBSERVE THE ANNUAL BILL OF RIGHTS DAY IN A MANNER THAT EMPHASIZES THE DOCUMENT'S MEANING AND IMPORTANCE. - ratified title
