H*3919 (Rat #0436, Act #0383 of 1994) General Bill, By Simrill

A Bill to amend Section 12-36-510, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the requirements for retailers to obtain a retail license before engaging in business, so as to include festivals among those special events for which a retailer files a special events sales tax return and is not required to have a retail license and to define "festival".
