H 3927 Joint Resolution, By Altman

Summary: Charleston County exempt from certain provisions relating to finance and taxation

A JOINT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE X OF THE CONSTITUTION OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1895, RELATING TO FINANCE AND TAXATION, SO AS TO EXEMPT CHARLESTON COUNTY FROM SECTIONS 1, 2, 3, 4, AND 6 REQUIRING THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO PROVIDE FOR THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF AD VALOREM TAXES ON PROPERTY LOCATED IN A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION AND TO DEVOLVE THOSE POWERS AND RESPONSIBILITIES UPON CHARLESTON COUNTY COUNCIL FOR PROPERTY LOCATED IN CHARLESTON COUNTY.
