H 3953 General Bill, By Klauber, Quinn, Campsen and Taylor

Summary: Criminal solicitation of a minor, sex offenses; Crimes, Electronic communication, Computers, Internet, Law Enforcement

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 16-15-342 SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR THE CRIME OF CRIMINAL SOLICITATION OF A MINOR, AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS PROVISION; BY ADDING SECTION 23-3-70 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT DIVISION UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES MAY ISSUE A SUBPOENA TO OBTAIN SPECIFIED INFORMATION FROM A PROVIDER OF ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION SERVICES OR REMOTE COMPUTING SERVICES; TO AMEND SECTION 16-15-445, RELATING TO THE SEIZURE AND FORFEITURE OF EQUIPMENT USED IN COMMITTING CERTAIN CRIMES, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THIS PROVISION APPLIES TO THE CRIME OF THIRD DEGREE SEXUAL EXPLOITATION OF A MINOR; TO AMEND SECTION 16-15-375, RELATING TO DEFINITIONS RELATING TO CERTAIN CRIMES AGAINST MORALITY AND DECENCY, SO AS TO REVISE THE DEFINITION OF "SEXUAL ACTIVITY"; AND TO AMEND SECTION 16-3-800, RELATING TO DEFINITIONS OF CERTAIN TERMS RELATING TO OFFENSES RELATED TO SEXUAL PERFORMANCE BY CHILDREN, SO AS TO REVISE THE DEFINITIONS OF THE TERMS "SEXUAL PERFORMANCE", "PERFORMANCE", AND "PROMOTE".
