A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 6-11-65 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT ELECTORS OF A SPECIAL PURPOSE DISTRICT MAY PETITION FOR A REFERENDUM ON THE QUESTION OF WHETHER THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SPECIAL PURPOSE DISTRICT SHOULD BE ELECTED; BY ADDING SECTION 6-11-66 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT IN THOSE DISTRICTS WHICH ADOPT THE REFERENDUM THE COMMISSIONERS MUST BE ELECTED ON AN AT-LARGE BASIS IN A NONPARTISAN ELECTION CONDUCTED AT THE TIME OF THE GENERAL ELECTION; AND TO AMEND SECTION 6-11-70, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO IMPLEMENTATION OF ELECTION REQUIREMENTS, SO AS TO EXEMPT CERTAIN DISTRICTS FROM CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS.
