A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING CHAPTER 28 TO TITLE 17 SO AS TO ESTABLISH THE "SOUTH CAROLINA INNOCENCE INQUIRY COMMISSION" WHOSE PURPOSE IT IS TO INVESTIGATE AND DETERMINE CREDIBLE CLAIMS OF FACTUAL INNOCENCE OF A CONVICTION THAT REQUIRES AN INDIVIDUAL TO VOLUNTARILY WAIVE CERTAIN RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES.
