H*4442 (Rat #0235, Act #0516 of 1996) Joint Resolution, By Vaughn, Anderson, Cato, Easterday, Haskins, R.J. Herdklotz, M.F. Jaskwhich, McMahan, Rice, Tripp and Wilkins

A Joint Resolution to provide that the school day of August 28, 1995, missed by the students of the school district of Greenville County when the district's schools were closed due to record-setting rains, heavy flooding, and closed roads is exempted from the make-up requirement of the Defined Minimum Plan that full school days missed due to extreme weather or other circumstances be made up.
