### H 4472 Joint Resolution, By Kirsh, D.W. Beatty, T.E. Huff, K.G. Kempe and R.M. Young

A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to Section 3 of Article XVII of the Constitution of South Carolina, 1895, relating to grounds for divorce, so as to provide that a divorce may be allowed on the ground of continuous separation for a period of six months instead of one year.
