**H\*4514 (Rat #0384, Act #0298 of 2002) General Bill, By McGee, Knotts, Bingham, Coates, Koon, Lourie and Whatley**

**Summary:** Law enforcement officer candidates, period of time in which must obtain certification extended under certain circumstances

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 23-6-430, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO CERTIFICATION OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT IN ADDITION TO EXCEPTIONS TO THE ONE-YEAR RULE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE PERIOD OF TIME WITHIN WHICH A CANDIDATE MUST OBTAIN THE CERTIFICATION REQUIRED TO BECOME A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IS AUTOMATICALLY EXTENDED FOR AN ADDITIONAL PERIOD EQUAL TO THE TIME THE CANDIDATE PERFORMED ACTIVE DUTY OR ACTIVE DUTY FOR TRAINING AS A MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL GUARD, THE STATE GUARD, OR A RESERVE COMPONENT OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES, PLUS NINETY DAYS; AND TO AMEND SECTION 23-6-445, RELATING TO CERTIFICATES AS A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER BEING ISSUED TO CERTAIN RETIRED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A RETIRED SOUTH CAROLINA OR FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WHO MEETS CERTAIN QUALIFICATIONS MUST BE ISSUED A CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZING HIM TO SERVE AS A CERTIFIED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.-amended title
