**H\*4691 (Rat #0428, Act #0352 of 2000) General Bill, By Jennings, Harrison, Altman and Knotts**

**Summary:** Probation agents, to enforce criminal laws; Courts, Probation, Parole, and Pardon, Prisons, Corrections Department

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 24-21-280, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE GENERAL DUTIES AND POWERS OF PROBATION AGENTS, SO AS TO CLARIFY THAT A PROBATION AGENT HAS THE POWER AND AUTHORITY TO ENFORCE THE CRIMINAL LAWS OF THE STATE.
