Summary: Property tax exemptions for veterans

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 12-37-220, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS ON PASSENGER VEHICLES AND DWELLING HOMES PROVIDED TO VETERANS MUST BE EXTENDED TO A VETERAN'S SURVIVING SPOUSE WHO ESTABLISHES RESIDENCY IN THIS STATE SUBSEQUENT TO THE DEATH OF THE VETERAN, IF THE VETERAN, BUT FOR RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS, COULD HAVE QUALIFIED FOR THE EXEMPTION; TO DELETE REFERENCES TO SPECIFIC WARS, FOR PRISONERS OF WAR AND TO PROVIDE THAT PRISONER OF WAR STATUS FOR PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS ON A VEHICLE MUST BE CERTIFIED BY THE COUNTY OFFICE OF VETERANS AFFAIRS; AND TO CHANGE FROM TWO TO ONE VEHICLE FOR WHICH A PRISONER OF WAR MAY RECEIVE A PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION.
