**H\*4805 (Rat #0517, Act #0384 of 1998) General Bill, By McGee, Barrett, J. Brown, Campsen, Clyburn, Easterday, Fleming, Gourdine, Harrell, Harrison, Haskins, B.L. Jordan, M.H. Kinon, Kirsh, Klauber, Knotts, Limehouse, Martin, McKay, Meacham, Moody-Lawrence, Robinson, Simrill, Spearman, Stuart, Wilkins and Woodrum**

A BILL TO AMEND ARTICLE 7, CHAPTER 3, TITLE 23, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY, SO AS TO FURTHER PROVIDE FOR THE REGISTRATION OF JUVENILES, INCLUDING REQUIRING THE PARENTS OF A JUVENILE TO ENSURE THAT THE JUVENILE REGISTERS; DELETING EAVESDROPPING FROM AND ADDING KIDNAPPING, IF A SEXUAL OFFENSE IS INVOLVED, TO THE CRIMES REQUIRING REGISTRATION; TO REVISE CERTAIN REGISTRATION PROCEDURES AND PROCEDURES FOR OBTAINING INFORMATION, INCLUDING SPECIFICATIONS FOR OBTAINING REGISTRY INFORMATION ON JUVENILES; TO REQUIRE THAT THE PSYCHIATRIC OR PSYCHOLOGICAL TREATMENT BE PROVIDED TO JUVENILES WHO HAVE COMMITTED CRIMES REQUIRING REGISTRATION; TO PROVIDE CRIMINAL PENALTIES FOR USING INFORMATION FROM THE REGISTRY IN THE COMMISSION OF A CRIME, AND TO PROVIDE IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY; TO AMEND SECTION 20-7-7805 RELATING TO FAMILY COURT DISPOSITIONAL AUTHORITY IN JUVENILE DELINQUENCY PROCEEDINGS, SO AS TO REQUIRE THE COURT TO ORDER PSYCHIATRIC OR PSYCHOLOGICAL TREATMENT WHEN A JUVENILE HAS COMMITTED AN OFFENSE REQUIRING REGISTRATION WITH THE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY; AND TO AMEND SECTION 20-7-8510 RELATING TO CONFIDENTIALITY AND DISCLOSURE OF JUVENILE RECORDS, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT SUCH RECORDS ARE SUBJECT TO DISCLOSURE PURSUANT TO THE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY.-AMENDED TITLE
