Summary: Income tax credit for tuition, LIFE Scholarships, student eligibility revisions; Colleges and Universities, Schools

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 12-6-3385, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE REFUNDABLE HIGHER EDUCATION TUITION TAX CREDIT, SO AS TO DELETE THE REQUIREMENT FOR ELIGIBILITY FOR THE CREDIT THAT THE STUDENT HAVE GRADUATED FROM HIGH SCHOOL OR COMPLETED A HIGH SCHOOL HOME SCHOOLING PROGRAM WITHIN TWELVE MONTHS BEFORE ENROLLING IN THE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND TO AMEND ACT 418 OF 1998, RELATING TO LIFE SCHOLARSHIPS AND THE TUITION TAX CREDIT, SO AS TO REVISE THE EFFECTIVE DATE LIMITING TAX CREDIT ELIGIBILITY TO STUDENTS GRADUATING FROM HIGH SCHOOL DURING OR AFTER MAY, 1997.
