H 4912 General Bill, By Hayes and Bales

Summary: Motor vehicle property taxes, personal; Taxation, no additional taxes when license plate removed, transfer to new owner

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 12-37-2675, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE LEVYING OF TAXES ON A MOTOR VEHICLE TO WHICH A LICENSE PLATE HAS BEEN TRANSFERRED FROM ANOTHER MOTOR VEHICLE, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT NO TAX MAY BE LEVIED ON THE MOTOR VEHICLE TO WHICH THE LICENSE PLATE WAS TRANSFERRED UNTIL THE LICENSE PLATE EXPIRES AND THE TITLE AND REGISTRATION TO THE MOTOR VEHICLE FROM WHICH THE LICENSE PLATE WAS REMOVED IS TRANSFERRED TO A NEW OWNER; AND TO AMEND SECTION 56-3-1290, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE TRANSFER BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY OF A LICENSE PLATE PREVIOUSLY ASSIGNED TO A VEHICLE OWNER OR LESSEE FOR ONE VEHICLE TO ANOTHER VEHICLE OWNED OR LEASED BY THE SAME PERSON, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT BEFORE THE DEPARTMENT MAY COMPLETE THE TRANSFER, THE TITLE AND REGISTRATION TO THE VEHICLE FROM WHICH THE LICENSE PLATE WAS REMOVED IS TRANSFERRED TO A NEW OWNER.
