H 5054 General Bill, By Jennings, Altman, Bauer, Harrison and Maddox

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 50-21-114, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO IMPLIED CONSENT TO CHEMICAL TEST OR ANALYSIS OF BREATH, BLOOD, OR URINE OF PERSONS ARRESTED FOR OPERATING WATERCRAFT OR EQUIPMENT, SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR A COMBINATION OF CHEMICAL TESTS OR BREATH, BLOOD, AND URINE TO DETERMINE THE PRESENCES OF ALCOHOL AND DRUGS WHEN THERE IS PROBABLE CAUSE TO BELIEVE A PERSON VIOLATED OR IS UNDER ARREST FOR OPERATING SPECIFIED WATERCRAFT AND EQUIPMENT WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL OR DRUGS OR A COMBINATION OF ALCOHOL AND DRUGS.
