### **S\*0506 (Rat #0518, Act #0520 of 1994) General Bill, By M.T. Rose and Leventis**

A Bill to repeal Section 22-5-120, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to arrest for crimes committed in magistrate's presence, and to amend Sections 14-25-95, 14-25-105, 18-3-10, 18-3-60, 18-3-70, and 22-3-760, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to cases in and appeals from magistrate's courts and municipal courts, so as to provide that these appeals must be to the court of common pleas rather than to the court of general sessions.-amended title
